- Introduced/Availability:** 1977 in Bremen, Germany; available nationwide.
- Beer Category/Style:** High-End European Import – Dark German Pilsner
- Taste Profile:** A rich and surprisingly smooth beer, **Beck's Dark** features a lingering, slightly sweet aftertaste. The deep copper color is the result of specially roasting the barley malt. Unlike dark ales, Beck's Dark is a bottom-fermented lager which creates a robust flavor and full body while retaining the refreshing properties of a lager beer.
- Ingredients:** Brewed in Bremen, Germany, the **Beck's** family of beers is made in accordance with the "*Reinheitsgebot*," the German Purity Law of 1516, which stipulates that only four natural ingredients can be used in the brewing process: barley malt, hops, water and yeast. **Beck's Dark** is five percent alcohol by volume (ABV).
- Packaging:** **Beck's Dark** is available in 12- and 24-ounce glass bottles.
- How to Serve:** The full body of **Beck's Dark** pairs well with German-style foods such as sausages and other grilled meats. The roasted malt flavor also complements flourless chocolate cake, apple pie and other desserts.
- Interesting Facts:** **Beck's Dark** is one of the leading imported German dark beers in the United States.
