It also undergoes a longer brewing process to produce a lighter taste, and fewer calories.</p>
<b>Interesting Facts:</b>	Both brands are distributed in select United States markets. Their introduction marked Anheuser-Busch’s first entry into the clear-bottle, packaged-draft market.
