<b>Beer Category/Style:</b>	High-End Import; Czech Pilsner
<b>Taste Profile:</b>	Sweet and citrus-like with some strong lemon notes, <b>Staropramen</b> pours a deep golden color and features an impressive white puffy head. It finishes with a strong dryness that beckons for another taste.
<b>Ingredients/Brewing:</b>	<b>Staropramen</b> is brewed using first-class Czech malt, Zatec hops and an exclusive yeast stream that gives this beer a very special character. Cold maturation in lager tanks gives it a floral bouquet and rounded taste. <b>Staropramen</b> is five percent alcohol by volume (ABV).
<b>Packaging:</b>	<b>Staropramen</b> is available on draught and in 11.2-ounce bottles.
<b>How to Serve:</b>	Dry yet thirst-quenching, <b>Staropramen</b> is best complemented by strong cheese, spicy/hot seafood and meats, and Asian or spicy Italian cuisine.
<b>Interesting Facts:</b>	The <b>Staropramen</b> Brewery was established on the left bank of the Vltava River in Smichov, Prague, in 1869. The first exports of Staropramen to Austria, Germany, Switzerland and even the United States began in 1884. <b>Staropramen</b> is imported and distributed in the United States by Anheuser-Busch, Inc.
