## Shock Top Belgian White

<b>Taste Profile:</b>	<b>Shock Top Belgian White</b> is a medium-bodied, unfiltered Belgian-style wheat ale, with a smooth, citrus mouthfeel and a naturally cloudy, light golden color.
<b>Ingredients/Brewing:</b>	<b>Shock Top Belgian White</b> is brewed with orange, lemon and lime peels and coriander.
<b>How to Serve:</b>	The beer is best enjoyed in a tall, wide-mouthed glass. To serve the brew perfectly, follow these pouring guidelines: pour the brew down the side of the glass until about one-half inch of brew is left in the bottle. Lay the bottle on its side and roll it gently back and forth, mixing the remaining yeast that has settled at the bottom. Pour the rest of the brew, producing a nice, thick collar of foam. <b>Shock Top Belgian White</b> pairs well with fresh salads, chicken dishes and Asian cuisine.
